Dr. Manuel J. Frausto, age 86, entered into rest Thursday, August 28, 2025 in Del Rio, Texas after a valiant battle with Parkinsons Disease. He was born March 18, 1939. He was preceded in death by his parents, Ubil and Alicia Frausto. Sister, Marie Wofford.
