It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Robert ("Bob") Martin Mazur, age 75, on October 6, 2023.

Bob was a beloved father, grandfather, brother, and friend. He passed away unexpectedly from natural causes at his mom's home in Del Rio, TX, where he had been living since 2020 while he cared for her in her final years. Bob was born on the Fort Belvoir Army Base in Virginia on August 26, 1948.

He and his younger sister Rose were raised mostly in Erie, PA by his mom Irene Wawrzyniak and Grandfather Bernard ("Ben") Warzynak. Bob attended Tech Memorial high school in Erie. While in high school he secured an apprenticeship at Swanson Erie Corporation, where he ended up working as a tool maker for most of his career. Bob enjoyed watching baseball, playing golf and poker, reminiscing about the

cars he owned, practical jokes, making people laugh, spending time with family, cooking for loved ones, and hanging out at the various east side clubs. Bob always made time to visit family, including 20+ trips to visit his son, daughter-in-law and two grandkids in California, his sister and brother-in-law in Denver, and his mom in Texas.
